**2006 Dundee Hills Estate Pinot Gris**  
ESTATE GROWN IN THE DUNDEE HILLS

**Vineyard source:** Black Family Estate, Dundee Hills, Oregon

True to the cool climate varietal characteristics of Alsatian Pinot Gris, this wine is deliciously bright, fresh and crisp. There's an interesting minerality and acidity on the palate balanced by soft floral aromas of white rose petal and apple blossom. Implications of nectarine, pear and melon combined with fresh meringue and Meyer lemon zest lay the foundation for a lovely texture and crisp yet silky mouthfeel.

At harvest, the fruit was hand sorted and, after 100% whole cluster pressing, the juice was cold-settled and racked off the lees. Slow fermentation in stainless steel tanks at low temperatures maintained the subtlety of the fruit.

In 1993, Pinot Gris clones sourced from some of the best vineyards in Alsace were planted across 12 acres in the highest elevation of the Black Family Vineyard at 650 ft above sea level. Attentive farming and crop yields maintained at no more than 3 tons per acre have consistently led to elegant, balanced Pinot Gris setting the standard for Oregon's most popular white wine.
