The embodiment of elegance and finesse in winemaking, The Four Graces 2006 Reserve Pinot Noir is perfectly balanced with seamless tannins and the ripe, lush red berry fruit profiles indicative of great Dundee Hills Pinot Noirs.

With a translucent, deep ruby color, this wine has subtle aromas of violets and cloves along with blackberries and plums. The palate shows chocolate bordering on mocha, cinnamon and nutmeg, with the black cherry and tobacco-leather flavors shared by the Pinot Noirs from the family's vineyard.

This Reserve is the result of ongoing observation in the vineyard to select the best fruit from specific rows and blocks. The final blend was determined by individual barrel selection after the wine had aged for 13 months in French oak (46% new). The wine was then cellared for a further 7 months before release.
