## 2007 Dundee Hills Pinot Gris

ESTATE GROWN IN THE DUNDEE HILLS

**Vineyard source:** Black Family Estate, Dundee Hills, Oregon

This Pinot Gris is a delicious representation of the highly-acclaimed Oregon white wines from the 2007 vintage. At The Four Graces, attentive farming practices and hands-on attention throughout the growing season allowed the vines to carry the grapes through inclement weather at harvest. Cool winds held botrytis at bay and the fruit delivered to the winery was of exceptional quality.

The hand sorted grapes received 100% whole cluster pressing. The juice was then cold-settled and racked off the lees. Under the watch of veteran winemaker Laurent Montalieu, slow fermentation in stainless steel tanks at low temperatures maintained the subtlety of the young wine.

True to the varietal, this Pinot Gris is pleurably bright, fresh and crisp. Golden Delicious apples, lychee fruit and a hint of red grapefruit on the palate. Characteristic of the vineyard, there's an interesting minerality and acidity on the palate balanced by soft floral aromas of white rose petal and apple blossom. The silky finish and fresh, full mouthfeel are indicative of a great Pinot Gris.

In 1993, Pinot Gris clones sourced from some of the best vineyards in Alsace were planted across 12 acres in the highest elevation of the Black Family Estate Vineyard at 650 ft elevation. Crop yields maintained at no more than 3 tons per acre have consistently led to elegant, balanced Pinot Gris setting the standard for Oregon's most popular white wine.
