



2007 Dundee Hills Reserve Pinot Noir

ESTATE GROWN IN THE DUNDEE HILLS

The embodiment of elegance and finesse in winemaking, The Four Graces 2007 Reserve Pinot Noir is perfectly balanced with seamless tannins and the ripe, lush red berry fruit profiles indicative of great Dundee Hills Pinot Noirs.

Aromas of pomegranate and Bing cherry, mingle with cloves and mocha, ending with notes of forest floor. The palate shows spice and light black pepper with some black cherry and raspberry. A well balanced wine with silky tannins and a nice body feel.

The Dundee Hills Reserve Pinot Noir is the result of ongoing observation in the vineyard to select the best fruit from specific rows and blocks. The Black Family Estate Vineyard which produces this wine, boasts the jory soils well known for their iron-rich, fertile characteristics.

The grapes were hand picked at peak ripeness. The clusters were then hand sorted and fermentation took place over 7 days with punchdowns three times daily. Barrel aged for 11 months in 40% new oak, the wine was then cellared for a further 14 months.
