



2008 Dundee Hills Pinot Blanc

ESTATE GROWN IN THE DUNDEE HILLS

White peach, honey and butterscotch combine on the nose with lightly toasted hazelnuts. An invitingly fresh zest of lime flavor is followed by Asian pear, jicama and grapefruit. This is a full bodied wine with a long finish.

The clones were grafted onto phylloxera-resistant rootstocks 3309 and 101-14 and trained into an upright, double guyot-trellising system. These plants have now established great balance, carrying a consistent crop of 2 ½ -3 tons per acre. Care is taken in the vineyard to thin the leaves on both sides of the canopy to maximize air flow and sun exposure resulting in the even ripening of golden berries.

The five-acre parcel of Pinot Blanc is situated in the cooler, higher elevations of the picturesque Black Family Estate at the entrance to Dundee with vistas of the Willamette Valley, Mt Hood and beyond.
