



2008 Dundee Hills Reserve Pinot Noir

ESTATE GROWN IN THE DUNDEE HILLS

Aromas of cherry, pomegranate and strawberry, mingle with violets. A dusting of mocha and hints of vanilla can be found. The palate shows spice with black pepper and some black currant notes. Silky tannins lead to a nice finish for this well balanced wine.

The Dundee Hills Reserve Pinot Noir is the result of ongoing observation in the vineyard to select the best fruit from specific rows and blocks. The Black Family Estate Vineyard boasts jory soil which is well known for its iron-rich, fertile qualities.

The grapes were hand picked at peak ripeness. The clusters were then hand sorted and fermentation took place over 13 days with alternating Pump Overs and Punch Downs. Barrel aged for 14 months, the wine was then cellared for a further 10 months.
