Earthy and elegant, fruit forward with smooth, expressive tannins, this wine bears all the hallmarks of a great New World Burgundy.

Reminiscent of raspberries, strawberries, plums, and Rainier cherries, the 2009 Willamette Valley Pinot Noir is vibrant and delicious in its youth yet has the soft, focused tannins to suggest ageing with grace.

Over 9 months in French oak has contributed a velvet softness to the mouthfeel without masking the lovely red to black fruit characteristics. The color is a deep garnet and the aromas are quintessential Oregon Pinot Noir.

Sourced from the Salmon Safe (certified) and L.I.V.E.-farmed Black Family Estate Vineyard in Oregon's acclaimed Dundee Hills, this Pinot Noir benefits from vine age and sustainable farming.
