With a deep ruby red hue, this lovely Pinot Noir shows hints of strawberries and vanilla on the nose. Plum, cherry and light tobacco combine with lovely tannins. A long, elegant, silky finish makes this a great Pinot Noir.

Over 16 months in French oak has contributed a velvety softness to the mouth feel without masking the lovely red to black fruit characteristics.

Sourced from the Salmon Safe (certified) and L.I.V.E. - farmed Doe Ridge Estate Vineyard in Oregon's Yamhill-Carlton District, this Pinot Noir benefits from vine age and sustainable farming.
